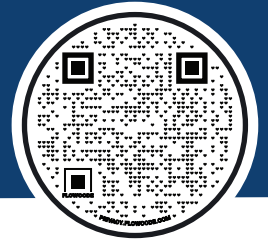

THE VIRGINIA CAREER AND LEARNING CENTER WEBSITE

The Virginia Career and Learning Center for School Mental Health Professionals (CLC) website offers professional development and career opportunities for school counselors, school social workers, school psychologists, and other licensed school mental health professionals in Virginia Public Schools. The site is funded by a federal award to the Virginia Department of Education (VDOE).

The CLC website provides an abundance of resources and instructional modules that will help school mental health professionals (SMHPs) foster safe and inclusive school communities and promote emotional wellness for students. The CLC has three important content areas:

- **The Learning Center** is frequently updated with new conference sessions and video courses to enhance professional knowledge. Many courses have quizzes with certificates that document engagement hours.
- **The Credential Hotspot** section, accessible to all SMHPs in the featured school divisions, provides training modules created by VDOE content area experts. SMHPs can earn certificates and collect badges that document completion of the modules.
- **The Resource Library** features carefully selected resources that are meant to support SMHPs as they support students. The Topic-Specific Resource Library gives guidance on critical and timely topics and the Role-Specific Resource Library provides valuable content tailored to each SMHP role..

The Learning Center hosts 2 types of videos that are relevant to all school mental health professionals: conferences and courses. Content can be explored choosing the **By Conference**, **By Course** or **By Topic** filters to find what best fits your interests and needs.

Exploring by BY CONFERENCE

This option accesses virtual synchronous conference sessions and symposia hosted by VDOE and is frequently updated. Subject matter experts present ready-to-use professional strategies, perspectives, and self-care pathways on timely topics for all SMHPs.

Exploring by BY COURSE

Specific courses designed by the VDOE Office of Specialized Student Services comprise most of the resources available in the Learning Center. Some courses consist of instructional video modules with knowledge checks and certificates that document engagement hours and some courses are a series of asynchronous presentations from invited subject matter experts. All courses address current issues facing SMHPs.

Use the dropdown menu to view the courses available.

Exploring by BY TOPIC AND SEARCH BAR

The dropdown menu under By Topic allows for exploration of content related to a specific topic of interest, for example, depression, military families, trauma. Conferences and courses are showcased in the results.
